The John Frost Bridge at Arnhem

The Hollows  
Hartenstein Museum  
St Elizabeth's Hospital

Oosterbeek Cemetery  
Driel Polish Memorial

### Day Four: Nijmegen

The Waal Bridge at Nijmegen

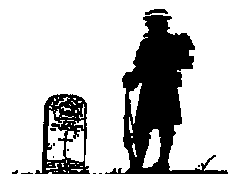
